Kudos to Kim's Martial Arts and Fitness, located in Brentwood, for sending four students to the 2009 USAT National Championships/Junior Olympics held recently in Austin, Texas.



Master Craig Munster, a fourth-degree black belt, competed in the male 19-30 national Poomsae team division.

This was his first national tournament and he ended up in 10th place.

Munster competed with some of the students that were on the national team last year and missed advancing to the second round by 0.08.

Cornelia Moore, a second-degree black belt, competed in the women's ages 41-50 division.

She came home with a silver in board breaking (Kyukpa), and also placed second in Poomsae (forms) and tied for fifth in sparring (Kyorugi).

Zachary Dunois, a first-degree junior black belt, competed in the male 12-13 division.

He earned fourth place in Poomsae and tied for fifth place in sparring.

Eli McCary, a red belt, competed in the men's ages 18-32 senior division. McCary captured a gold medal in forms and a silver medal in sparring.

More than 2,500 athletes participated in the week-long tournament held at the Austin Convention Center.
